CHARGING VIOLATIONS OF:

COUNT 1: CONSPIRACY, a Class 5 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. §13-1003 (Both Defendants)

COUNT 2: INTERFERENCE WITH AN ELECTION OFFICER, a Class 5 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. §16-1004(A) (Both Defendants)

The 93rd Arizona State Grand Jury accuses **PEGGY SUZANNE JUDD (001)** and **TERRY THOMAS CROSBY (002)**, charging on this 27th day of November, 2023, that in or from Maricopa County, Arizona:

COUNT 1

CONSPIRACY

During a period of time beginning on or about October 11, 2022, and ending on or about December 1, 2022, PEGGY SUZANNE JUDD (001) and TERRY THOMAS CROSBY (002), with the intent to aid the commission of an offense, did agree with one or more persons that at least one of them would engage in conduct constituting the offense and one of the parties committed an overt act in furtherance of the offense, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1003, 16-1004(A), 16-642, 16-646, 16-648, 13-301, 13-302, 13-303, 13-304, 13-306, 13-701, 13-702, and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when PEGGY SUZANNE JUDD (001) and TERRY THOMAS CROSBY (002) with the intent to aid the commission of an offense, did agree with one or more persons that at least one of them would engage in conduct constituting the offense and one of the parties committed an overt act in furtherance of an offense, namely INTERFERENCE WITH AN ELECTION OFFICER, by conspiring to delay the canvass of votes cast in Cochise County in the General Election held on November 8, 2022, and to delay the transmission of that canvass to the Secretary of State's Office.

COUNT 2

INTERFERENCE WITH AN ELECTION OFFICER

During a period of time beginning on or about November 14, 2022, and ending on or about November 28, 2022, PEGGY SUZANNE JUDD (001) and TERRY THOMAS CROSBY (002), at an election, did knowingly interfere in any manner with an officer of such election in the discharge of the officer's duty, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 16-1004(A), 16-642, 16-646, 16-648, 13-301, 13-302, 13-303, 13-304, 13-306, 13-701, 13-702, and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when PEGGY SUZANNE JUDD (001) and TERRY THOMAS CROSBY (002), as a part of the 2022 Statewide General Election, knowingly interfered with the efforts of Arizona Secretary of State Katie Hobbs to complete the canvas of the 2022 Statewide General Election, by preventing the Cochise County Board of Supervisors from canvassing the election within the time period required by law, and preventing the timely transmission of the county's returns to the Secretary of State's Office for inclusion in the statewide canvass.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 21-425, the Grand Jurors find that the offenses described above were committed in Cochise and Maricopa Counties, Arizona.
