SUPREME COURT

In Case No. 2024-0247, <u>Democratic National Committee & a. v. New Hampshire Secretary of State & a.</u>, the court on September 27, 2024, issued the following order:

At or before 4:00 p.m. on October 3, 2024, the parties shall file brief memoranda, not to exceed 4,500 words, addressing the following questions:

- 1. Does the principle set forth in <u>Purcell v. Gonzalez</u>, 549 U.S. 1, 4-6 (2006), which this court applied in case no. 2018-0208, <u>Petition of New Hampshire Secretary of State & a.</u> (Oct. 26, 2018 order, attached), militate against our issuance of a decision in this appeal prior to November 6, 2024?
- 2. Does the recent enactment of HB 1569 (Laws 2024, chapter 378), which repeals statutory provisions at issue in this case, render the appeal moot as of November 11, 2024?
