HOUSE BILL NO. 4093

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO KYNOA TROTTER OF PIKE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Kynoa Trotter of Pike County, Mississippi,
- 6 who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his conviction
- 7 for the crime of burglary nonresidential on October 31, 2017, in
- 8 Pearl River County, Mississippi, for which he was sentenced to
- 9 serve seven (7) years in the custody of the Mississippi Department
- 10 of Corrections. On March 4, 2019, he was convicted for the crime
- 11 of possession of a firearm by a convicted felon in Walthall
- 12 County, Mississippi, for which he was sentenced to two (2) years
- 13 in the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections and
- 14 five (5) years probation under the supervision of the Mississippi
- 15 Department of Corrections.
- 16 He was discharged on May 19, 2020, due to expiration of
- 17 sentence. The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted

- 18 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
- 19 lawful manner.
- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after its passage.
