PURPOSE

To approve a fund balance appropriation in support of the acquisition of technology and equipment needed for the 2024 Presidential election cycle.

BACKGROUND

In preparation for a potentially record-breaking turnout Presidential Election, we must ensure that we have enough equipment, personnel, and support to execute the election to the best of our ability. Due to the increase in Cobb County's population, we are requesting an increase in election equipment to accommodate an additional Satellite Site for Advanced In-Person Voting and to add more scanners to reduce wait times. With more equipment and more locations, we need more carriers, or "hubs" to transport and set up that equipment. Additionally, with the severe increase in concern for election worker safety, we're requesting funds for a security guard for our office, as well as panic buttons for Poll Managers. To ensure that all registered voters in Cobb County have all the information they need on how, where, and when to vote in November, we're proposing a voter information mailer that would go to each Registered Voter Household. Most of the other costs are associated with the steep increase in personnel needs that come with a Presidential election, as well as the purchase of poll pad printers for all of our poll pads to severely reduce voter wait times.

It is further requested that the approval of this appropriation also include authorization for the Finance Department, Budget Division, to make the necessary transfers from the approved designated contingency to the appropriate expenditure codes to process payments as needed.

IMPACT STATEMENT

This acquisition of technology and equipment will be from a fund balance appropriation within the General Fund and will have no ongoing impact on any county budgets.
