ORDER

Before the Court is Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order ("Motion") (ECF No. 2), filed November 4, 2024. The Court ordered Defendants to respond and specifically confirm that no observers will be present in Texas polling locations or election tabulation centers. ECF No. 5 at 2. Both parties have now filed a Joint Notice of Compliance and specifically confirmed that no observers under 52 U.S.C. § 10305 will be within Texas polling locations or election tabulation centers. ECF No. 8. Having reviewed the parties' Notice of Agreement and Notice of Compliance, the Court **DENIES AS MOOT** Plaintiffs' Motion.

Plaintiffs are **ORDERED** to file a case status update **within 14 days of this Order** updating the Court on the status of the lawsuit and whether Plaintiffs continue to have a redressable injury.
